WHAT ARE CERTIFICATED LOCATIONS?

The Motor Caravanners' Club is authorised by the Department of the Environment to issue Certificates of Exemption, so owners of land may permit up to five Motor Caravans to be accommodated without the need for planning permission or a site licence.

These are called Certificated Locations.

WHAT DOES HAVING A CERTIFICATE MEAN?

A landowner or tenant may take up to five Motor Caravans on his Certificated Location, subject to two conditions as printed on the Certificate. Applicants must confirm that they are willing to keep these two conditions before a Certificate is issued.

The conditions are:

1. Not more than five Motor Caravans on the land at any one time.
2. No Motor Caravan shall be allowed to stay for longer than 28 consecutive days.
3. Tents and Trailer Tents cannot be accommodated on our Certificated Locations.

The Certificate may be withdrawn if any of these conditions are broken.

WHAT DO I HAVE TO PROVIDE?

- Level area of land
- Not less than a third of an acre
- Screened from view.
- Good road access.
- Safe drinking water supply.
- Chemical disposal point
- Rubbish bin
- Public Liability Insurance

Flush toilets are not necessary as our members carry their own chemical toilets. However a toilet disposal point is essential. Ideally this point should connect to the main line of drainage since formaldehyde based chemical fluids are used in this type of toilet and could interfere with the working of the tank or plant. If a main sewer / drain is not available two options remain. We can advise members that only 'Green' toilet fluid may be used at your site, or you may insist that no chemicals are disposed on your site

You, as occupier, will be responsible for:

- water point
- chemical toilet disposal point
- bin for dry refuse
- rates, as charged by your local authority.

ACCESS

The easier access to your site the better your trade. Modern motor caravans tend to vary from 2m to 2.5m (6 ½ to 8 ½ feet) wide and 5.5m to 7m (18 – 24feet) long whilst some are over 9m (30 feet). The majority of our member's vehicles have a MTPLM (GVW) of 3.5tonnes.

Before we can issue a Certificate, a club official may need to visit your land and we will check that Local Authority has no reasonable objections. Any land within the boundaries of a National Park or a particularly sensitive area, may need further consultation with the appropriate authority.

If a site Licence is already held, a Certificate will not be issued. Not more than one Certificate can be issued to any one landholding, irrespective of the area.

As you will appreciate, not every application is successful. Certificates are only issued with the utmost responsibility and we exercise great care in selecting suitable sites.

HOW WILL YOUR MEMBERS KNOW ABOUT MY SITE?

Each Certificated Location has free entries in our Sites & Touring Guide (published every two years) and on our very active website. Every member receives a copy of our Sites & Touring Guide, which will include your directions to your Site

We provide you with a sign you should display at the entrance. This tells members of your certified status and shows that they are at the correct location

WHAT DO I CHARGE?

The fee for each 24 hours for a Motor Caravan varies depending on the area and demand.

We can advise you what other Certified Location owners are charging in your area.

The Motor Caravanners' Club Locations are certificated for open use so they are not 'members only'. You may allow anyone to use your camping facilities, but we hope you will give preference and a small discount to Members of The Motor Caravanners' Club.

The final decision, of course is yours – you set the fees and receive the income.
